The Beginning of a Warm Front

Since its beginning in 1986, Project Bundle-Up, a partnership between The Salvation Army and WTAE Channel 4, has provided hundreds of thousands of needy seniors and children with new winter outerwear and a personal shopping experience.



The Project Bundle-Up Facts:

- Each year, 7,500 children and seniors are given the opportunity to purchase new coats, hats, scarves, gloves, and boots — at no cost to them.
- Project Bundle-Up continues to serve this ever-increasing need each year through its outreach and with the continued support of local businesses, individuals, schools and foundations.
- Every \$50 we receive gives us a chance to provide winter outerwear to another child.
- \$100 will clothe a needy senior citizen with new winter outerwear.

Who We Serve

Project Bundle-Up serves needy children ranging from infants to 18 years of age. Disabled and ailing seniors, from 62 years of age and older, also benefit from the program's services. Eligibility is based on economic need – the application process examines a family's monthly income, bills, number of children and employment status.

Project Bundle-Up proudly assists underprivileged children and seniors in The Salvation Army's 28-county Western Pennsylvania Division. The Salvation Army has 45 Worship & Service Centers and 100 volunteer Service Units that encompass the Western Pennsylvania Division.
